# Canada-B.C. Job Grant

Convert your Basic BCeID to a Business BCeID now!

With the new online CJG application system you will need to have a BCelD to apply. If your organization is a not-for-profit and currently has a Basic BCelD, you'll need to convert it to a Business BCelD. This process takes 5-10 days for approval. If you are going to be applying under the priority stream of funding, then you are encouraged to get cracking on this ASAP. It is expected that priority stream funding for training starts between Sept 1 - Dec 3, 2017, will be fully committed within 1.5 months of the May 1st application intake.
