In preparation, ASPECT members will be receiving calls from our office to update our member contact information.

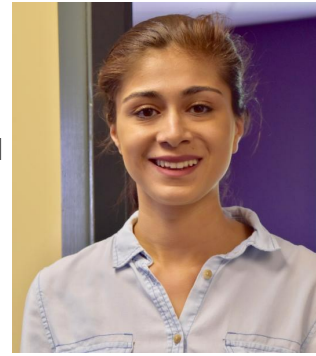


