Please, just vote!



Yesterday's charged [leadership candidate debate](#) proves that election season is an exciting time here in BC. Politicians use the election results to inform their agendas once elected. You are probably familiar with wording in acceptance speeches such as "clear mandate" when someone wins by a landslide or "humbly accept" when it's more of a close call. As a constituent, one of the best ways we can comment on the issues is to get out and vote. Apathy is not our friend here.

Many of the issues that impact our sector, and more importantly, the people our agencies our tasked to help, have made it into the political platforms: childcare, addiction and mental health services, housing, and transportation. Also, issues surrounding jobs and how we access our natural resources -- top talking points in recent years -- are at the forefront of many town hall discussions, especially those outside of the urban centres.

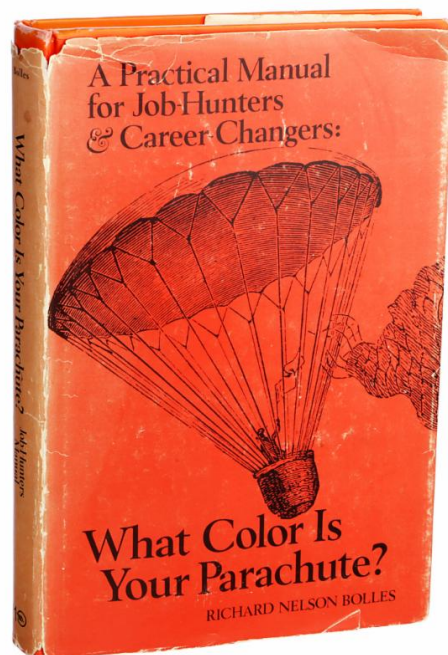

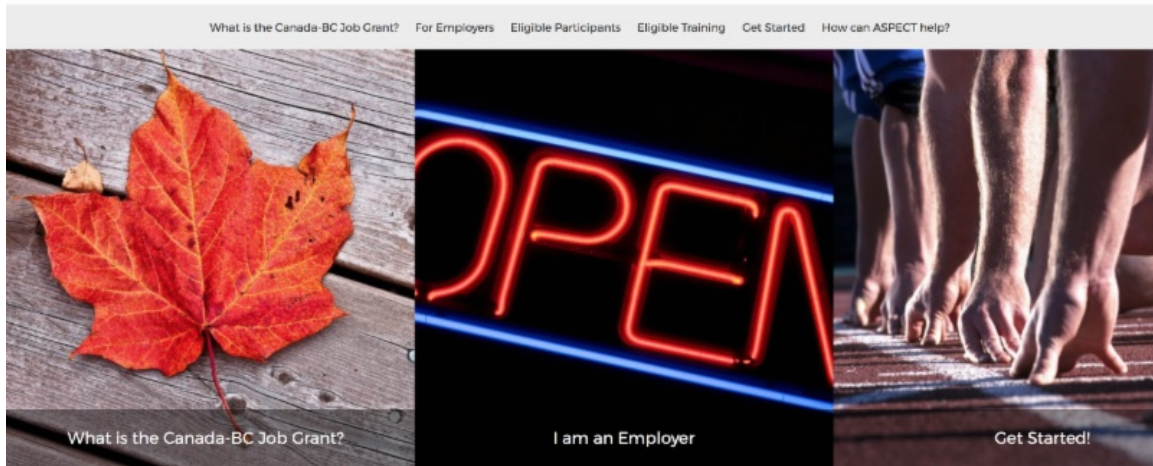

If you are interested in training for your staff that starts after September 1, 2017, we encourage you to apply online after May 1st as soon as you can. Funding for priority stream applicants will likely be in demand and funding may run out sooner rather than later when compared to other times of the year.

Applications using the new online system will start May 1, but in order to use the new system, both employer and employee will need to have a [BCeID](#).

There have been a number of eligibility changes recently. Check in with ASPECT about your training plans. As a delivery partner, ASPECT BC can assist with CJG applications under four streams of funding to which eligible employers can apply.
