Forest Fires Close Employment Centres

Several of our members in the interior have been on my mind this week as WorkBC centres, training programs, and social service organizations have closed and evacuated because of the forest fires in the region. Although it's been horrific following the devastation, I've been struck by the good news of communities across the province coming together to support those affected.

They have closed their Work BC Centres in Ashcroft, 100 Mile
