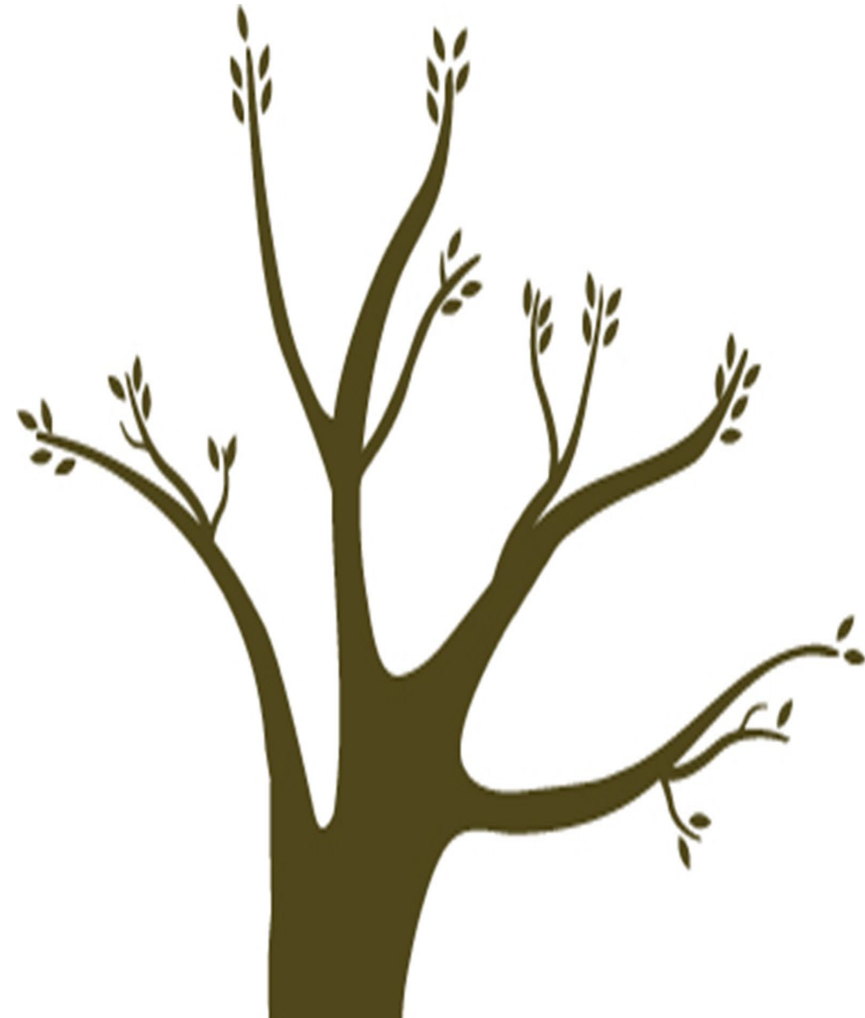

# WHAT ARE SKILLS FOR SUCCESS?

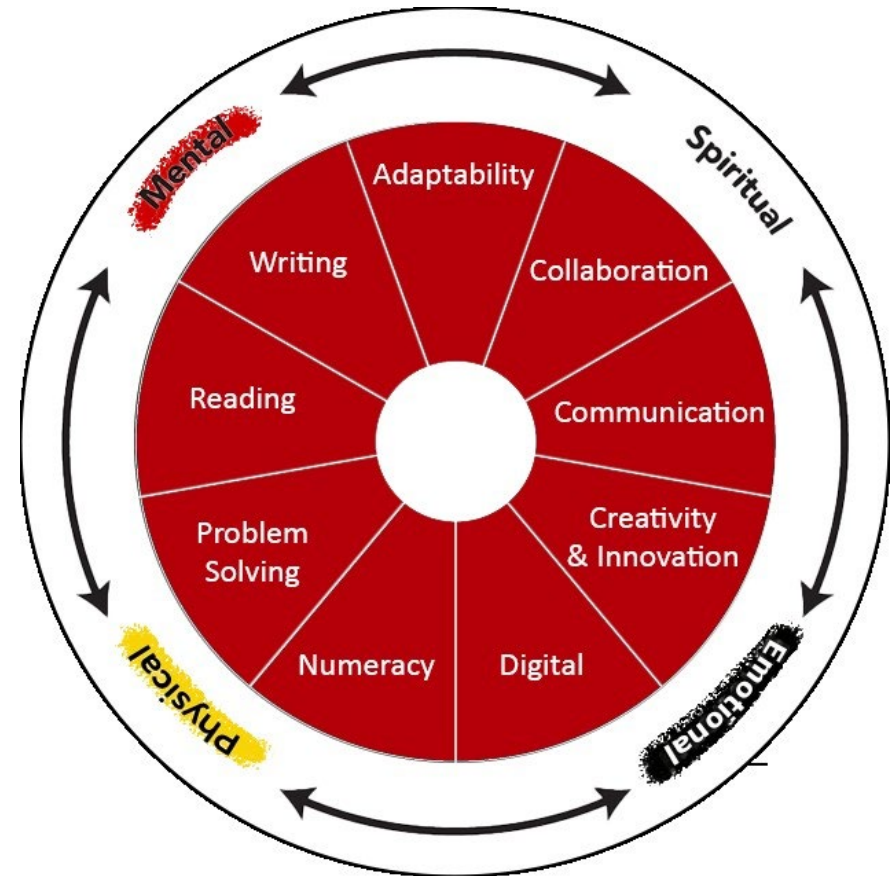
Are the **skills needed** to participate and thrive in **learning, work and life;**

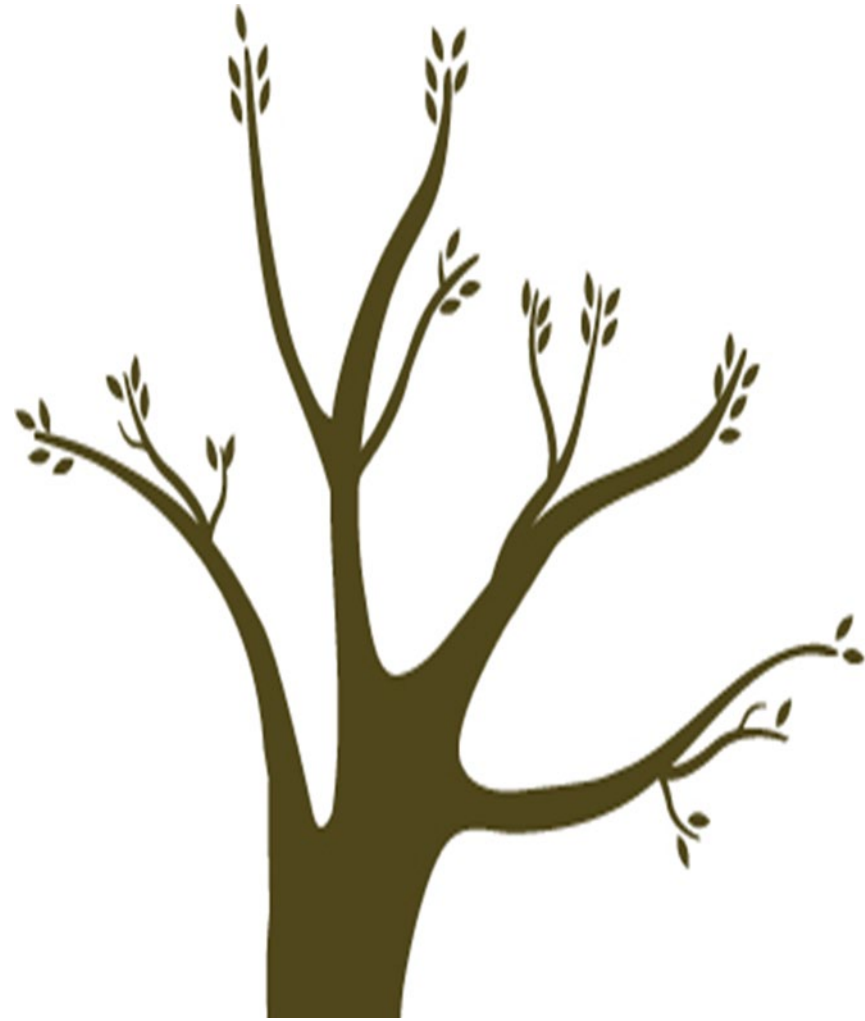
