CEO Report

CCCBET: A Pan-Canadian Perspective



Presenting on behalf of CCCBET at the <u>Amplify</u>, Ontario's Employment Leadership Conference.

This past weekend, I was in Toronto meeting with my provincial counterparts to undertake strategic planning for the Canadian Council of Community-Based Employability Training (CCCBET). With the February appointment of the Minister of Employment, Workforce Development and Labour, Hon. Patty Hadju, and the delay in the Skills Link contract awards, we had a lot to talk about!

Through CCCBET, we are your voice to the federal government on issues of policy and practice. We provide leadership through a national

perspective. After 5.5 hours of discussions, we resolved to focus our efforts on the following issues:

Involve or Devolve

- Federal programs such as Skills Link are under-funded. The Federal Government no longer has the infrastructure to deliver funding in a timely fashion.
- The lag between when an RFP response is submitted and a contract is awarded is sometimes years after the proposed start date.

Policy & Practice

 Funding agreements must be redesigned to maximize local flexibility in response to local labour market conditions and trends.

A Place at the Table

CCCBET is asking to have a place on the Labour Market Information Council to
ensure that the needs and concerns of the labour supply are addressed in a way
that is equal to that of the needs of employers.
